Top reasons to grow Sugar & Spice viburnum:

- Pink buds open to very fragrant white flowers
- Outstanding fall color
 - Perfect as a specimen or hedge
- -Deer resistant

Viburnum carlesii 'Sugar & Spice'

- **Use:** A heavy flowering cultivar with the delicious fragrance the species is known for. This cultivar was selected for its smaller, yet abundant, fragrant flowers, which fill the air with a sweet-spice aroma in early spring. An excellent choice for a captivating specimen plant! Large flower clusters emit a spicy-sweet scent in mid-spring, and autumn brings an unforgettable display of bright red foliage. This deer resistant, shade tolerant shrub will beautify your landscape for years to come.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun(best) to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Tolerant of all soils and positions as long as it is not too dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly growing to 4-6' tall and 4-6' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green, 2" leaves that are burgundy red in fall.
- **Flower:** The spring flowers start out a deep reddish-pink and mature to bluish white. PLEASE NOTE: To produce berries, you'll need another carlesii (same species) but a different cultivar.
