Viburnum 'NCVX3'

- **Use:** Developed by Dr. Tom Ranney at NCSU, Yang viburnum is an elegant, compact evergreen hybrid (*V. davidii* x *V. propinquum*) that has thick, glossy, bluish-green leaves and showy round clusters of white spring flowers. The flowers are followed by elliptical blue fruit if pollinated by Yin® viburnum. It's a true four-season beauty!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Prefers moist loams, but tolerates a wide range of soils. Established plants have some drought tolerance. Prune as needed immediately after flowering. Tolerates clay and growing under black walnut trees.
- **Growth:** Quickly growing to 2' tall and 4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thick, leathery leaves are deeply veined. Foliage is deer resistant, but deer will eat flowers.
- **Flower:** Airy, white flowers in spring. If planted with companion Yin viburnum, you'll also look forward to amazing blue fruits in summer.
