Thick, leathery leaves are deeply veined and are accompanied by white flowers in spring. If planted with companion Yang viburnum, you'll also look forward to amazing blue fruits. It's a true four-season beauty! Both Yin™ and Yang™ will grow nicely without tons of pruning, making them easy to maintain in gardens and landscapes.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Prefers moist loams, but tolerates a wide range of soils. Established plants have some drought tolerance. Prune as needed immediately after flowering. Tolerates clay and growing under black walnut trees.
- **Growth**: Quickly growing to 2-4' tall and 4' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7b-9; Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Thick, leathery leaves are deeply veined. Foliage is deer resistant, but deer will eat flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> You want both of them because you need them to pollinate one another in order to get the blue fruit in fall. They're handsome enough without fruit, though.
