

Kern's Pink Viburnum



Viburnum plicatum 'Kern's Pink'

- **Use:** A breathtaking shrub with huge ball-shaped flowers ranging in color from pink to white in spring, showy almost beyond words, flowers are sterile so the shrub does not produce fruit; compact size, bronze-tinted foliage add up to a fine specimen plant .
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Requires well-drained soil and good moisture. Needs extra water during a drought. should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers. Will not tolerate standing water.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-8 feet tall and 7-8 feet wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It has attractive deep purple-tipped dark green foliage throughout the season. The serrated pointy leaves are highly ornamental and turn an outstanding orange in the fall.
- **Flower:** Features showy balls of pink flowers with white overtones at the ends of the branches in mid spring.
