Viburnum tinus 'Spring Bouquet'

- **Use:** Large fast growing evergreen shrub that has large bright green leathery leaves and provides a showy profusion small fragrant white flowers in spring . The robust nature of Sweet Viburnum allows for a wide range of growing conditions but it will perform best in partial shade. Can be used as a background hedge, screen, or can become treelike if given enough time and space.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun(best) to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Tolerant of all soils and positions as long as it is not too dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly growing to 4-8' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark green, 2" leaves.
- **Flower:** With very attractive carmine buds which are followed by pink tinged white flowers throughout the winter from October onward. Berries turn from red to black and are attractive to birds. The main bloom period occurs in late winter to early spring.
