- **Use:** Bird lovers, this flowering shrub is for you! Gracefully arching shrub boasts densely clustered, 1" funnel-shaped red blooms which are especially attractive to hummingbirds. Spilled Wine® weigela shares the fabulous deep purple foliage and bright pink flowers of the classic Wine & Roses® weigela but in a smaller size. This useful plant grows wider than tall, making it the perfect choice for edging beds or walkways and for incorporating under windows in your landscaping. Like all weigela, it is deer resistant and very easy to care for.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2-4 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Oblong, 4.5-inch burgundy leaves provide a lush appearance.
- **Flowers:** In late spring, 1.5-inch, cherry-red trumpet-shaped flowers of radiant red will literally cover your shrub with hummingbirds.
