

Stunner® Weigela



Weigela x 'Spring 2' USPP30185

- **Use:** Fascinate the senses this season by adding Stunner® to your outdoor retreat. Vibrant pink blooms pop against sleek dark purple foliage creating a showy, elegant look. Superb as a solo specimen, or plant three or more together to create a colorful hedge. Versatile plant excellent for foreground of shrub beds or as background for flower borders.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Best flowering occurs in full sun, but light shade is probably beneficial in zone 8 as the heat can possibly overpower them. Prefers well-drained soils but fairly adaptable to other soil types. If necessary, prune immediately after the spring bloom.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 4-5 ft. tall and 3-4' wide. Blooms on new and old wood.
- **Hardiness:** ***Zone 4-7 (8 if given some afternoon shade an not planted in too hot a location, but better further North Georgia); Shrub***
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Oblong, 4.5-inch plum green leaves provide a lush appearance.
- **Flowers:** The fragrant pink flowers appear in late spring and again in autumn and attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Pro tip: to encourage re-bloom, trim lightly just after the first blooms have finished. Attracts hummingbirds. Can be used as a cut flower.



A versatile shrub. Several together work well as an informal flowering hedge or border. Scattered throughout a bed, they provide beautiful bursts of color. Additionally, this weigela is a great option for containers, foundation plantings, and cut-flower gardens.
