Ivory Tower Yucca



Use to create contrasting textures as a garden accent or container specimen. A good firescaping plant. Excellent for use in xeriscapes.

Yucca filamentosa 'Ivory Tower'

- <u>Use:</u> Sword-like leaves boldly edged in ivory topped by tall spikes of fragrant, ivory white blooms. Forms dramatic clumps with age. Use to create contrasting textures as a garden accent or container plant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Forms clumps 3 ft. to 4 ft. tall and wide, with flower spikes 6 ft. tall.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-9 Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Grey-green edges and grey-green streaks within the ivory white center.
- <u>Flower:</u> From early to midsummer, spectacular sturdy flower stalks rise 3-4 feet tall from the center of the plant. The individual bell-shaped, creamy white flowers are 2-3 inches long and dangle from the stems like earrings.
