Tough, heat tolerant, and drought tolerant!



Yucca rigida 'Blue Sentry'

- <u>Use:</u> A very dramatic color addition to the landscape with a texture all its own, the Blue Sentry Yucca has sword-shape blue leaves that mature to a striking powder blue. Use to create contrasting textures as a garden accent or container plant. Excellent for use in areas where you can not water and have poor soil! While this plant does not have a pronounced spine tip, it is best not to plant in near close pathways.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun. Once established needs only occasional water. Requires well drained soil and once established, can survive some drought conditions.
- <u>Growth</u>: This is a smaller Yucca, being stemless or clump-forming, the height will max out at 2-3' (possibly 5' over time) feet with a 2-3' spread.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5a-9b; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Rosette of unusual blue-green leaves. Upon close observations you'll see a thin yellow margin on the leaves.
- **Flower:** Tall spikes of creamy white, bell-shaped summer flowers.
