

Dusty Zenobia



Zenobia 'Woodlander's Blue'

- **Use:** This member of the Ericaceae family is native to the southeastern U.S. The leaves are covered with a glaucous bloom giving them a silvery blue appearance. ***Native plant!***
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to partial shade; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites
- **Growth:** Moderate growth 2-3 ft. tall and 6 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5 -9 Shrub /Small tree.
- **Foliage:** Fall coloring is a beautiful mixture of oranges and reds. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** The nodding white flowers are 3/8" long in clusters in May and June. The flowers remind one of blue berry blooms.

Great for wet soil areas!
