Acer palmatum

- **Use:** Exquisite small tree with artistically branched stems forming a rounded crown. They are low-maintenance, drought-tolerant, and slow-growing specimen trees that enhance landscapes with four-season color and architectural elegance
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will not tolerate soggy or extremely dry soil.
- **Growth:** Moderately growing to 15 ft tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8, small tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deeply lobed, light green leaves have lovely red fall color.
- **Flower:** Distinctive double-winged, papery samaras (seed pods), often in bright red, which emerge in spring and mature for wind dispersal.
