- **Use:** This improved selection makes an extremely attractive garden or patio tree. It displays beautifully cascading branches with large, finely cut green leaves and golden fall color. A choice small tree for garden accents and containers in full to part sun in cool climates, dappled or afternoon shade in extremely hot areas. This cut-leaf Japanese Maple is a landscape feature by the terrace; perfection overlooking a pond.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will not tolerate soggy or extremely dry soil.
- **Growth:** Slowly reaches 8 to 10 ft. tall, 10 to 12 ft. wide, in natural form.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8, small sized tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deeply cut green foliage. Knockout fall foliage—changing from emerald green to bright gold tinged orange and red.
- **Flower:** Clusters of red to purplish inflorescences in late May and early June are often hidden by the foliage.
