

Sun Valley Maple



Why not appreciate the colors of the season in the comfort of your own backyard? With the purchase of the hybrid Sun Valley Maple Tree (acer rubrum 'Sun Valley') you can do just that this autumn!

Acer rubrum 'Sun Valley'

- **Use:** The brilliant red of this tree steals the show in autumn, but that doesn't mean it can't share the spotlight. Consider planting this maple alongside trees whose yellow and amber foliage can accent this red and show its full potential. Due to its compact growth and sturdy nature, this tree is a very popular pick by local government and parks and recreation services for city use. The Sun Valley Maple can be used in city parks, street and highway roadsides, and shade trees in residential areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will not tolerate soggy or extremely dry soil.
- **Growth:** It typically grows to 20' tall over the first 10 years, eventually maturing to as much as 30-35' tall in ideal growing conditions. 15-25' wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 4-8, Large Tree**
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; These maple leaves emerge with a red tinge and then mature to solid green before turning a brilliant red in fall.
- **Flower:** Has sterile red flowers in spring. This male selection was developed by the US National Arboretum and it does not produce any seed. No baby Maple trees popping up everywhere.
