Great focal point and specimen in parks and small gardens.

Cedrus deodora 'Karl Fuchs'

- **Use:** A striking evergreen with bright blue spring growth, that gradually matures to green, resulting in a unique shimmering effect throughout most of the year. Provides a striking vertical element in the landscape. Ideal as a specimen against a backdrop of darker green conifers or shrubs, or massed for a dramatic statement of color.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Watering can be reduced after establishment. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. Pruning time: winter.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 12 to 15 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide in 10 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-11; Tree
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. A trailing leader and pendulous habit giving it a softer more graceful appearance than other cultivars. The blue-green needles are 1.5 inches long. Its spring growth is a bright blue, maturing to green, giving this cultivar a very showy appearance.
- **Flower:** 3 to 4" bluish green cones on female trees.
