- <u>Use</u>: A slow growing dwarf Blue Atlas Cedar featuring fascinating form and color. It's dwarf height for a Deodar Cedar makes this unique little dazzler ideal for use in smaller garden spaces and containers.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Watering can be reduced after establishment. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. Pruning time: winter.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: No one knows the ultimate mature height, but adding 4 to 6 inches or so in height per year, you might expect 6 to 8 feet tall and 4 to 5 feet wide at 15 to 20 years of age.
- *<u>Hardiness</u>:* Zone 5a-8b; Tree
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Grey– green needles.
- *Flower:* 3 to 4" bluish green cones on female trees.
