

Burgundy Hearts® Redbud



Cercis canadensis 'Greswan' PP19654

- **Use:** A unique Redbud that features shimmering red-purple heart-shaped leaves that remain burgundy throughout the season. Pink-lavender flowers appear before the leaves in spring.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Thrives in full sun to partial shade and well drained soil. Water deeply once a week during the growing season. Pruning should be done after the blooms are finished in late spring to maintain its shape. Fertilize in late winter and late summer with a high phosphorus fertilizer. Mulch beneath the tree in the spring to maintain soil moisture and avoid temperature extremes.
- **Growth:** Grows 15 to 20 feet tall and 20 to 25 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Smooth, purple heart-shaped, deciduous foliage does not have significant fall color. The heart-shaped leaves hold their dark color longer in the summer, taking on reddish wine tones towards the fall.
- **Flower:** Stunning tiny pinkish-lavender flower clusters cover the entire tree in early spring before many other trees bloom.
