

Ruby Falls Redbud



Cersis canadensis 'Ruby Falls'

- **Use:** A lovely compact redbud tree with a weeping canopy that is perfect for a smaller-sized landscape. An excellent specimen plant with clusters of lavender-red, sweet pea-like blooms in spring. Small, semi-glossy, heart-shaped leaves turn yellow in fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Soil should be well-drained. Acidic soil is preferred, though it can tolerate a wide variety of soils. As long as it is properly established, it is moderately drought tolerant.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 6 to 8 ft. tall, 5 to 6 ft. wide. This is a relatively low maintenance shrub, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Small Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It has attractive burgundy deciduous foliage which emerges brick red in spring. The heart-shaped leaves are highly ornamental and turn yellow in fall.
- **Flower:** Stunning, lavender pea-like flowers with red overtones along the branches from early to mid spring before the leaves.
