- **Use:** *A beaming beacon for the landscape.* Bold, bright, and beautiful: that's Winecraft Gold™ smokebush. Round, waxy leaves emerge a sunny orange, soon take on a golden hue, then mature to a cheerful chartreuse for the season. In early summer, cloud-like green flower clusters cover the plant, and these turn into the pink "smoke" plumes that earn the plant its name. Naturally grows with a dense, oval shape that's ideal for adding a spot of bright color to partially shaded or sunny areas.
- **Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. Plant in full sun for best color and flowering. Drainage is very important so be sure to amend soil.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 4-6' feet tall and 4-6' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8b, Large shrub/ Small tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Colorful yellow foliage stays bright all season.
- **Flower:** In summer, it produces pink flower panicles. Its flowers have a long and fluffy shape. It isn't technically the flowers that create the hazy, smoke-like effect this plant is so loved for - it's the seedpods that form after the flowers have faded. Those seed heads give it the name "Smoke Bush"

Top three reasons to grow Winecraft Gold Smokebush:
1. Color and interest from spring through frost.
2. No pruning or special maintenance required.
3. Dwarf habit makes it easy to use with any sized home or yard.
