- **Use:** Transforming your garden or backyard into a tropical retreat has never been easier thanks to the Loquat. Plant them by themselves or intermingle this Asian beauty with a few palm trees and you can create a tropical paradise right at home.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun. Well-drained, rich soil. Adaptable to most soil types, but amend with red clay.
- **Growth:** Loquats will grow to about 10 feet high, making them a good size for a diversity of planting options.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The shiny, thick leaves with saw tooth edges.
- **Flower/ Fruit:** . delicate white flowers combine for a tropical look and fresh scent that will help you escape from the day's stress. The visual appeal and subtle fragrance aren't the only tropical features of the Loquat. Its juicy orange flesh has a delicious tropical flavor-like a sweet, tangy plum and a kumquat all in one.
