

Ginkgo/ Maidenhair Tree



In autumn the lovely leaves turn a brilliant, saturated yellow. This is one of the most favored and popular characteristics of the Ginkgo tree. Place it where you'll see the fall color display. This gorgeous deciduous tree is perfect for a street tree, shade tree or as a lawn tree.

Ginkgo biloba

- **Use:** It's also one of the oldest living types of trees. Botanical gardens around the world feature this beautiful "living fossil. Yes, this is the tree used in Ginkgo biloba supplements to improve memory, symptoms of dementia and blood flow. Bet you didn't know how pretty it is!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Easily grown in average, medium moisture soil in full sun. Prefers moist, sandy, well-drained soils. Tolerant of a wide range of soil conditions, including both alkaline and acidic soils and compacted soils. Also tolerant of saline conditions, air pollution and heat. Adapts well to most urban environments.
- **Growth:** Slow to moderate growing. 50-80' tall and 30-40' wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 3-9 Large Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; It features distinctive two-lobed, somewhat leathery, fan-shaped, rich green leaves with diverging (almost parallel) veins. Leaves turn bright yellow in fall.
- **Flower:** Trees can be either male or female.
