

# Biloxi Crape Myrtle



## *Lagerstroemia indica* 'Biloxi'

- **Use:** Biloxi grows well in limited soil spaces in urban areas such as along boulevards, in parking lots, and in small pavement cutouts if provided with some irrigation until well established. Very drought tolerant. Highly resistant to powdery mildew.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15' tall and 15-25' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-9a; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fresh green foliage in spring and summer and fall color is orange/brown.
- **Flowers:** Showy pale pink flowers appear mid-summer and have a long-lasting bloom time. Blooms on new wood.
