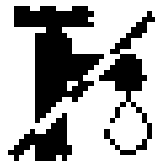


Double Dynamite® Crape Myrtle



Extremely attractive when used as a focal point in the mixed border, mass planting, or a specimen planting



Lagerstroemia indica 'WHIT X' PP #27,085

- **Use:** A double explosion of color throughout summer on this re-blooming (up to 100+ days) crape myrtle with colorful foliage that emerges deep purple and matures to a dark purple-green, and a profusion of large, sterile flower clusters that emerge bright pink and age to intense cherry red. Resists mildew, and is heat tolerant. An ideal upright shrub for landscape or container.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Reaches 8 to 10 ft. tall, 8 to 12 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage emerges a very dark purple in spring, and as the foliage ages during the summer, it becomes a dark green color.
- **Flowers:** Intense cherry red flowers darken as they age, sterile flower clusters won't produce seeds, so there's no need to worry about unwanted seedlings around your yard.
