- **Use:** A dwarf crapemyrtle with serious flower power! This heavy-blooming, dense, rounded plant has rich dark pink-red blooms in summer, and nice clean, green foliage. It adds lots of color to summer landscapes, and fits easily into container gardens and residential landscapes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 3-4' tall and 2-4' wide. Dwarf habit gives that this plant has a wide range of landscape applications. It's a very nice addition to flower gardens as well as landscapes.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-12; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Glossy green foliage. Offers excellent fall color.
- **Flowers:** A heavy blooming, dense, mounded plant with rich, dark pink-red blooms and clean foliage. The flower show begins in summer and carries straight on into fall. Make sure you plant this where it can be seen and enjoyed. There will be jealous admirers.
