## *Lagerstroemia indica* 'Pocomoke'

- **Use:** The U.S. National Arboretum presents Lagerstroemia 'Pocomoke', the second in a new series of miniature hybrid crapemyrtles. Plant this rosy-flowered little beauty in all of your summer fun areas. Great as a container plant on patio or deck. It will charm with its diminutive bushy habit and rose-pink flowers. Give your garden a southern accent with the lovely 'Pocomoke'!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 19 inches tall and 3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; Small shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small, glossy, dark green foliage emerges maroon; bronze-red fall color. Highly tolerant to powdery mildew.
- **Flowers:** Deep rose-pink flowers in mid to late summer, approximately two weeks after flowers appear on standard hybrid varieties of crapemyrtle; persist until frost.
