

Red Rooster Crape Myrtle



Lagerstroemia indica 'Piilag-III'

- **Use:** A beautiful mid-sized, upright grower with large panicals of brilliant red blooms. The disease resistant foliage starts as a maroon-red in spring and transitions into a dark green. It is the perfect plant to use as a specimen or grouping in any size garden. Dead-heading will encourage reblooming into the fall. Highly resistant to powdery mildew and also has some drought tolerance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Mid-size, upright growth habit to 8 to 10' high. Handout available on our website with pruning instructions.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. New growth is a red to red-purple color and will fade to dark green later in the season.
- **Flowers:** Abundant brilliant true red flowers produced from summer to fall.
