

# Scarlet Colorama Crape Myrtle



## *Lagerstroemia x 'JM1'*

- **Use:** Abundant and colorful clusters of hot scarlet-red flowers come to life against gorgeous deep green foliage from summer through fall on this new selection with a self-branching habit reaching 15 to 20 feet tall and 8 to 12 feet wide. This beauty will provide up to 100 days of explosive color during summer. But the color show doesn't stop after the summer flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves from daily sprinklers.
- **Growth:** Vigorous, self-branching habit, reaching 15 to 20 feet tall and 8 to 12 feet wide. Excellent as a landscape specimen.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 6-10; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous In the fall, the foliage begins to fade from dark green to orange-red shades.
- **Flowers:** Deep scarlet-red blossoms throughout the summer. Flowering begins in July and will continue until frost.
