Lagerstroemia indica 'Tuscarora'

- **Use:** Handsome specimen plant with large inflorescences in summer. Brownish red exfoliating bark. Good mildew resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 20' tall and 15' wide. Shape into a tree by cutting out weak shoots.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fall color is orange red.
- **Flowers:** Watermelon red flowers are recurrent from June through September.
