Lagerstroemia indica 'Twilight'

- **Use:** Deep purple flowering crape myrtle with attractive bark and pretty fall color. Moderate sized, multi-trunked tree makes an excellent border tree along a property line. Once established, is drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-15' tall and 6-8' wide. Shape into a tree but cutting out weak shoots. Handout available on our website.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; It can be grown as a broad shrub or as a horizontal tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. New growth is a red to red-purple color and new wood is red in color, the leaves will fade to dark green later in the season.
- **Flowers:** With large, lightly fragrant flower clusters that bloom from early June until frost. The darkest purple on the market!
