

Thunderstruck Lavenderblast Crape Myrtle



Lagerstroemia 'Thunderstruck™ Lavender Blast™'

- **Use:** Masses of lavender flowers bloom on near-black, glossy foliage in summer through fall. This Crape myrtle matures lightning-fast at 12 to 15 feet tall and 8 to 12 feet wide. Flashy blooms and foliage create a Perfect Storm in the landscape. Once established, is drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15' tall and 8-10' wide. Shape into a tree but cutting out weak shoots. Handout available on our website.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-10; Large shrub or Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is an intense glossy, black.
- **Flowers:** Doves of flashy lavender blooms that persist from late spring until fall.
