

Thunderstruck™ Rumblin' Red™ Crapemyrtle

- Why You'll Love It:**
- Year-Round Interest: From its fiery red blooms in the summer to the rich, bronze foliage in the fall, this Crapemyrtle keeps your garden dressed to impress all year long.
 - Drought Tolerant: Once established, it laughs in the face of dry spells, making it a low-maintenance dream for the forgetful waterer.
 - Pest Resistant: Spend less time worrying about pests and more time enjoying the view. This plant's natural resilience means it's tough where it counts.
- **Use:** Thunderstruck Rumblin' Red Crape Myrtles are a newer variety of red tree form crape myrtles. They are very similar to Ebony Flame Crape Myrtles but they grow taller and make a larger impact as a focal point in your yard. The deep red flowers make for a very vibrant show in the summer against nearly-black foliage. Masses of ruby-red flowers bloom on near-black, ruffled foliage in summer through fall. Flashy blooms and foliage create a Perfect Storm in the landscape.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
 - **Growth:** This Crapemyrtle matures lighting-fast at 12 to 15 feet tall and 8 to 10 feet wide. Handout available on our website.
 - **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Large shrub or Tree
 - **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is an intense glossy, ruffled, black.
 - **Flowers:** Masses of ruby-red flowers bloom in summer through fall.
