- <u>Use:</u> Thunderstruck Rumblin' Red Crape Myrtles are a newer variety of red tree form crape myrtles. They are very similar to Ebony Flame Crape Myrtles but they grow taller and make a larger impact as a focal point in your yard. The deep red flowers make for a very vibrant show in the summer against nearly-black foliage. Masses of ruby-red flowers bloom on near-black, ruffled foliage in summer through fall. Flashy blooms and foliage create a Perfect Storm in the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- <u>Growth</u>: This Crapemyrtle matures lighting-fast at 12 to 15 feet tall and 8 to 10 feet wide. Handout available on our website.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Large shrub or Tree
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Foliage is an intense glossy, ruffled, black.
- **Flowers**: Masses of ruby-red flowers bloom in summer through fall.
