Magnolia stellata 'Waterlily'

- **Use:** Absolutely one of the the most beautiful trees on the garden scene, the Star Magnolia is another perfect flowering tree for small to medium size landscapes. Bears slightly fragrant white flowers that blanket this compact tree in early to mid Spring before emergence of the deep green leaves. Train as a deciduous shrub, or small ornamental tree that will provide years of visual enjoyment in your garden. Makes a great gift for new home-owners, especially those with a limited area for planting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun, but tolerates part sun, and tolerates just about any well-drained garden soil.
- **Growth:** Grows 15' tall. Space 10-15' apart.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9; Tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Elongate leaves.
- **Flower:** Scads of large, fragrant snowy-white double-flowers from mid-March through April before its leaves emerge.
