## ***Magnolia virginiana***

- **Use:** A lovely small patio, shade or specimen tree. This magnolia's stunning flowers burst in late spring and early summer, giving you a blizzard of blossoms. Often grown as ornamental or showpiece trees. This is one of the most pest resistant magnolia trees you can find. It can tolerate very moist soils, and can even survive standing water. Native.p
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or part shade in any humus-rich well-drained soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 12 to 20 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Tree.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark, thick glossy green leaves with white undersides.
- **Flower:** Two-three inch-wide, lemon-scented creamy flowers grace the plant in late spring and sporadically through the summer. The fragrant blooms contribute significantly to the plants appeal.
