

Granny Smith Apple Tree



Grow your own apples! You must buy 2 different trees.

Malus pumila 'Granny Smith'

- **Use:** Please be sure to read the *Home Garden Apples* article from UGA at our checkout. There is too much information to print here. You will need a pollinator with the same code.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sunlight, and plenty of it, is a key to increasing fruit production. Pick an area where the trees will be in the sun most or all of the day. The early morning sun is particularly important because it dries the dew from the leaves thereby reducing the incidence of diseases. If the planting site does not get plenty of sun, then you can't expect the best performance from the tree. Well-drained, rich soil. pH of 5.5 to 6.5 necessary.
- **Growth:** Mature height 18-20 ft. Plant at 25 ft apart.
- **Hardiness:** 6-10; Tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower/ Fruit:** Matures late October to early November. Yellow-green. Apple of excellent quality. Good all-purpose variety. Code B Pollinator
