

Weeping White Spruce



Picea glauca 'Pendula'

- **Use:** Pendulous branches covered with short, densely packed needles. Adds a graceful, weeping effect to the landscape. Makes a superb accent specimen, or plant in groups as a windbreak or screen. Superb container specimen. **This is a high maintenance tree that will require regular care and upkeep so we only recommend for seasoned gardeners.**
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They need to be protected from summer sun in zone 7/8 so a little afternoon shade is preferred or they will get foliage burn. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Once established needs only occasional water. **NO RED CLAY and good drainage is a must. It has no significant negative characteristics.**
- **Growth:** Reaches up to 20 to 30 ft. tall, 6 to 10 ft. wide. When pruning is necessary, it is recommended to only trim back the new growth of the current season, other than to remove any dieback.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 2-8; Shrub Protect from afternoon summer sun burn in Zone 7/8.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Nice blue-green foliage that hugs the trunk, sweeping downward to create a fantastic impression.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..

A fine specimen plant to add texture to your garden.
