

# Pink Cascade® Cherry Weeping



This tree has year-round interest. In late winter and early spring it is simply covered in showy pink blooms, moving into summer its weeping form and bright green leaves seem to cool the air as it sways in even the lightest breeze. Fall brings red and yellow and after the leaves have fallen, its drooping bare branches lend a sculptural grace to the winter landscape.

## *Prunus x 'NCPH1' PP27579*

- **Use:** Naturally weeping branches are covered with showy, snow white flowers on this magnificent, compact, hardy specimen for the landscape. Produces very few red-black ornamental fruit in summer. Very disease and insect resistant. Great as a small patio or specimen tree. Be creative, drape it over a wall, make an archway, or create an espalier dragon with a pink mane! Exquisite in Japanese style or nature inspired gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. It is tolerant of pollution and all soils except very wet or chalky. This is a stunning profuse flowering cherry tree that has received the RHS Award of Garden Merit and is well worthy of a space in any sized garden. They are not drought-tolerant, so proper watering is a must.
- **Growth:** Slowly reaches 12 ft. tall, 12 ft. wide in natural form. Could hit 20' x 20' over a very long term as this is a long lived tree. To maintain the desired weeping pendulous form, remove all stems that grow vertically.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves (to 3 1/4" long) turn attractive shades of gold and orange in autumn.
- **Flower:** Bright pink flowers in early spring Flowers give way to small, sparse, black, inedible fruits.
