

Pink Snow Showers Weeping Flowering Cherry



Prunus x 'Pink Snow Showers' ('Pisnshzam')

- **Use:** Its elegant, arching branches are a flurry of sweet pink flowers in early spring, standing out against the silvery branches. Serrated, dark green foliage has no issue with unsightly shot hole disease, staying clean all season before developing into red and orange tones in fall. This vigorous grower quickly develops into a show-piece.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun(5-6 hours min). Soil should be well-drained. Acidic soil is preferred, though it can tolerate a wide variety of soils. They are not drought-tolerant, so proper watering is a must.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing (grafted), and grows up to 35 feet tall and 25-30' wide with pendulous branches
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4a-8b; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Serrated, dark green foliage has no issue with unsightly shot hole disease, staying neat and clean all season before developing into red and orange tones in fall.
- **Flower:** A flurry of sweet pink flowers in early spring, standing out against the silvery branches.

- Large ornamental tree, but still elegant.
