

Japanese Stewartia



Once you have seen the fall color is unforgettable. Stewartia bark is spectacular, peeling off and exposing contrasting colors. It could be grown for this characteristic alone.

Stewartia pseudocamellia

- **Use:** A beautiful specimen shrub or tree, with year-round interest, if given the right conditions. Fall foliage has bright colors. The attractive flaking and peeling bark adds a special interest to the winter garden. An unusual specimen tree to add fall interest to your garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun /partial shade, Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** An excellent, small to medium-sized, may reach a height of 12 to 40 feet tall and 8 to 25 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Small-med Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green foliage turns yellow to red in the fall. Foliage turns sunny yellow and bright red in fall. Attractive peeling bark adds winter interest.
- **Flowers:** Lovely, delicate 3 in. white flowers with yellow stamens in summer for an extended period The fruits are greenish to brownish, oval, and hard capsules.
