

# Weeping Sargent's Hemlock



## *Tsuga canadensis 'Pendula'*

- **Use:** A most graceful dense mounding shrub with broadly spreading branches that create a weeping effect with the deep green, finely textured foliage. An exceptional accent for large rock gardens or border plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** For best results plant this tree in full sun, though it can tolerate some shade in the afternoon which may protect it from our scorching summer sun. Prefers well-drained, loam soil, though it can adapt to many other types of soil. It is also a good idea to shelter the tree from exposure to strong winds.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 5 ft. tall, 8 to 10 ft. wide, larger with age. You could see it get 10-15' tall and 30' wide over 20 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Needles are dark green, arranged in a 2-rank fashion, and are typically one-half long and one-eighth inch wide. The under-side of the needles display 2 whitish bands.
- **Flower:** Produces a few small, 1" cones in the springtime.

**A weeping specimen plant to add interest to your garden. Be sure not to hide its beautifully delicate texture behind anything taller.**
