Washingtonia robusta

- **Use:** This tall-growing palm can be seen all over Florida and portions of the desert southwest. Best success if grown in a container here, cold hardy to 20°F. Will still recover from dormancy if temp falls to 10 degrees. Good garden or patio tree, effective near pool. Great container specimen.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to partial sun. Once established needs only occasional water. Needs good draining soil, so do not plant in red clay.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 25 to 30 ft. and more tall, to 8 ft. wide crown. We still find it a good container plant at the pool!
- **Hardiness:** 7-10, Tree
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. A slender trunk topped with crowns of large fan-shaped evergreen fronds.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
