

Sundenia Dipladenia



Dipladenia 'Sundacrim Crimson'

Sundenia is ideal for patio pots and hanging baskets. Great to beat the heat in pots on your deck or near the pool.

- **Use:** Sundenia® dipladenias offer the large flowers loved in man-devillas but on a compact, manageable plant. Sundenia's® flowers are 3-5 inches in diameter, double the size of a typical dipladenia, all on glossy green foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2' tall and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Must bring inside in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Long oval leaves. Evergreen if brought indoors in winter, but needs lots of heat, sun, and humidity to thrive.
- **Flower:** Flowers are 3 in. to 5 in. in diameter—double the size of a typical dipladenia flower. Rich, bright pink trumpets bloom April–October nonstop!
