Great to beat the heat in pots on your deck or near the pool.

Dipladenia 'Sundacrim Coral'

- **Use:** The first Yellow in the Original series. Sunbeam has a high flower count and is several weeks earlier to bloom. It is well-suited for containers and hanging baskets.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone 9-11;** Annual, Must bring inside in the winter. Protect from temps below 50 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Long oval leaves. Evergreen if brought indoors in winter, but needs lots of heat, sun, and humidity to thrive.
- **Flower:** Buttery yellow trumpets bloom April– October non-stop!
