

Yellow Mandevilla



Dipladenia (Mandevilla) urchites lutea

- **Use:** So easy to grow! They will tolerate the hottest sun and humidity! Attracts lots of hummingbirds. Great to climb up your mailbox.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 36-48” in. tall or more. For more flowers pinch the tips of the stems occasionally early in the season.
- **Hardiness:** 8-11; Annual
- **Foliage:** Long oval leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Large yellow trumpets. Blooms April– October non-stop!
