

White Mandevilla



Mandevilla x amabilis 'White Delite'

- **Use:** So easy to grow! They will tolerate the hottest sun and humidity! Great to climb up your mailbox. Prefers to be rootbound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring them inside for the winter. In warm weather this twining vine displays pure white blooms. Cooler temperatures cause flowers to blush pink. Creates a cooling effect on hot summer days. A lovely choice for trellis or arbor.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Loves to be keep moist, but don't leave pot standing in water. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing twining stems to 15 to 20 feet long.
- **Hardiness:** 8-11; Annual, **Must bring inside in the winter.**
- **Foliage:** Evergreen if brought indoors in winter
- **Flower:** Large trumpets. Blooms April– October nonstop!
