

Petite Pink Oleander



Loves the heat and it is perfect for that hot spot with baking sun!

Nerium oleander 'Petite Pink'

- **Use:** Attractive hedge, border or accent plant. Perfect plant for hot Georgia summers and has little water requirements once established. Often used in Florida and California as a median planting on highways due to their ability to withstand heat, drought, and pollution. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6 feet tall in one season
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Annual, Tender perennial, Must have sandy soil to come back. While they often come back they will likely not bloom until August the 2nd year.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen as a houseplant
- **Flower:** Gorgeous soft bubble gum-salmon pink flowers.
