

# Mona Lavender Plectranthus



**Loves the sun or part-shade and super easy!**

## ***Plectranthus 'Mona Lavender'***

- **Use:** A striking new flowering houseplant from South Africa. Don't despair as the days shorten, because that's when Plectranthus 'Mona Lavender' begins an outstanding show of blooms atop dark green leaves, colored purple beneath. 'Mona Lavender' is an adaptable houseplant for partial shade, making a stunning debut after years of development at the Kirstenbosch Botanical Garden in South Africa.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in partial sun to full shade. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results, but don't leave them in soggy areas or too much water.
- **Growth:** Grows 1-2' tall depending on the amount you water and fertilize them.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11 Annual; Houseplant Heat tolerant.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous unless taken indoors.
- **Flower:** Long spikes of purple flowers from summer until fall.
