

# Shalimar Cross Vine



## ***Bignonia capreolata 'Shalimar'***

- **Use:** Glossy-leaved, evergreen, heavy-flowering vine that never fails to awe when sporting orange-red flowers in heavy bloom. On the roadsides, rambling through fence lines and tucked here and there in the wildlands of the South, the plant can make a strong statement. Put this vine in full sun in a modestly tended garden, and a cross vine in full bloom can literally take your breath away.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun preferred or at least 6 hours of afternoon sun.. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Continues to vine.....
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Vine
- **Foliage:** Glossy, evergreen leaves are opposite, oblong to 6 inches long and ½” to 2 inches wide.
