

Yellow Trumpet Vine



Campsis radicans 'Flava'

- **Use:** Vigorous climber that produces beautiful yellow, trumpet-shaped blooms, attractive to hummingbirds. Provide support such as trellis, fence or arbor for excellent colorful accent to patio, pathways or garden perimeter. Once established, thrives and blooms best with little care, other than annual pruning to control size. Suckers and self-seeds profusely.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun preferred or at least 6 hours of afternoon sun. Tolerates poor soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** These fast-growing vines will grab a wall, fence, or tree with their aerial roots, and can quickly grow to 30 feet.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4--9; Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Saw tooth edged leaves.
- **Flower:** The brightly colored, trumpet-shaped flowers attract hummingbirds from late summer to autumn.
