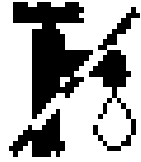


# Blue Jeanne Clematis



## *Clematis 'Blue Jeanne'*

- **Use:** For beautiful colors, extravagance of blooms, and graceful habit, nothing compares with Clematis, the queen of the flowering vines. Whether used on posts or fences, clambering through shrubs and trees, or following wire frames in borders, they will enrich the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Prefers to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun in the South.. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** *Grows 6– tall and 2-3’ wide* . Prune:group 2 blooming on new growth (basically reduce all stems by 1/2 after bloom season in Fall). Then, light pruning to the strong buds in April is recommended to promote branching. Support with a trellis of your liking. This clematis has repeat blooming, it is helpful to prune old flowers throughout the blooming season,after finished.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green foliage grows quickly. Compact grower.
- **Flowers:** New ! The sunny sky blue color of Manfred Westphal’s New Clematis breeding ‘Blue Jeanne’ is like no other! Not all blues are the same, this one is exceptional. Repeat bloomer, prune immediately after flowering. Excellent for a lovely container on the patio, but equally nice in a garden, even a small one!

**A must have vine in the garden for beginner Gardeners. Very rich free-flowering and non-stop blooming from May to September is more than one could ask for, but bring it back every year, that is the bonus!**
