Clematis 'Charmaine'

- **Use:** Impressive, 4-6" carmine flowers cover trellises, pergolas, and obelisks from late spring into autumn. Single, semidouble, and double flowers appear simultaneously. This unique, compact grower is perfect for adding color to containers and smaller gardens. For beautiful colors, extravagance of blooms, and graceful habit, nothing compares with Clematis, the queen of the flowering vines. Whether used on posts or fences, clambering through shrubs and trees, or following wire frames in borders, they will enrich the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Prefers to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun in the South.. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** **Grows 6-8' tall.** Pruning group 2. Remove dead or weak stems before growth begins. Check individual stems from the top down until you reach a pair of healthy buds, and prune just above them, removing the spindly or damaged growth above. Avoid heavy pruning or flowers will be lost.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone -9;** Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green foliage grows quickly. Compact grower.
- **Flowers:** An amazing strong red coloured clematis producing double, semi-double and sometimes single flowers. Flowers are between 10-15cm in diameter and plants has slighter darker shiny foliage.
